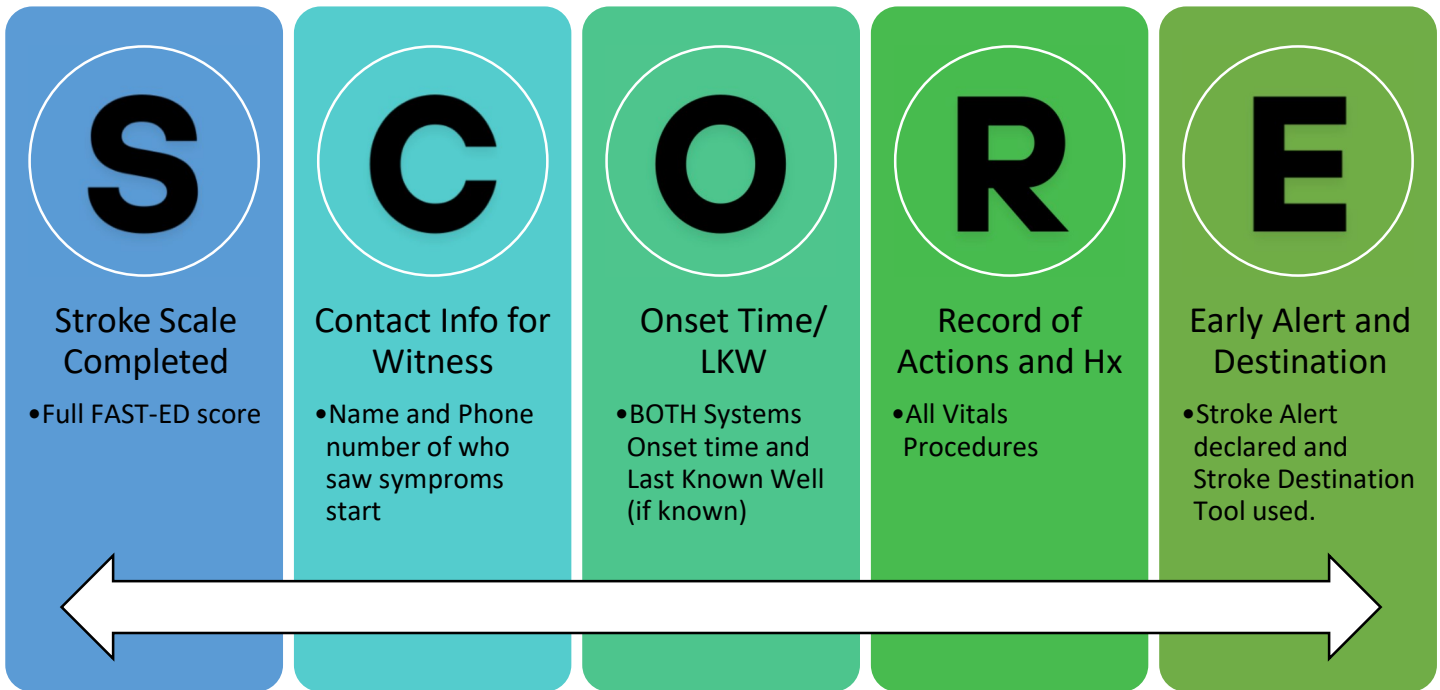


Documenting Suspected Cerebral Vascular Accident (CVA)



Steps for Stroke Documentation:

- 1. Stroke Scale Completed (FAST-ED):**
 - Complete the Field Assessment Stroke Triage for Emergency Destination (FAST-ED)
- 2. Contact Info for Witness:**
 - Document the Name/Phone of Witness to Event in the Stroke Tool
- 3. Onset Time / Last Known Well (LKW):**
 - Determine and document time intervals for EXACT Date/Time of Symptom Onset or Discovery and Last KNOWN Normal Time
 - Use the appropriate NULL value (⊖) only when the symptom onset or Last Known Well time cannot be determined or is unavailable after reasonable effort.
- 4. Record of Actions**
 - Document all vitals taken and procedures performed including (not limited to):
 - Blood Glucose
 - Vascular Access
 - Airway management
 - 12-lead ECG, if able
 - Document all current medications and medical history
 - Document in correct medications and medical history fields.
 - Document anti-coagulants other than Aspirin (ASA) answer.
- 5. Early Alert & Destination**
 - "STROKE ALERT" within 5 minutes
 - Scene Time less than 15 minutes (goal 10 minutes)
 - Stroke Destination Type Documented
