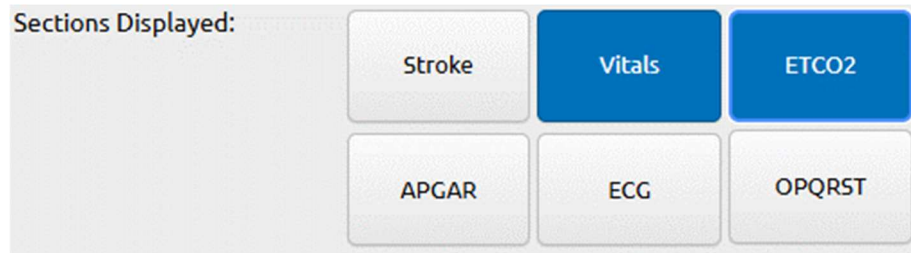


New Section Display Buttons

The Vitals Grid has been broken up into six sections matching these six buttons. These buttons are multi-select, which means you can choose more than one at a time. In addition, any data documented in any of these sections will display all the fields in that section.

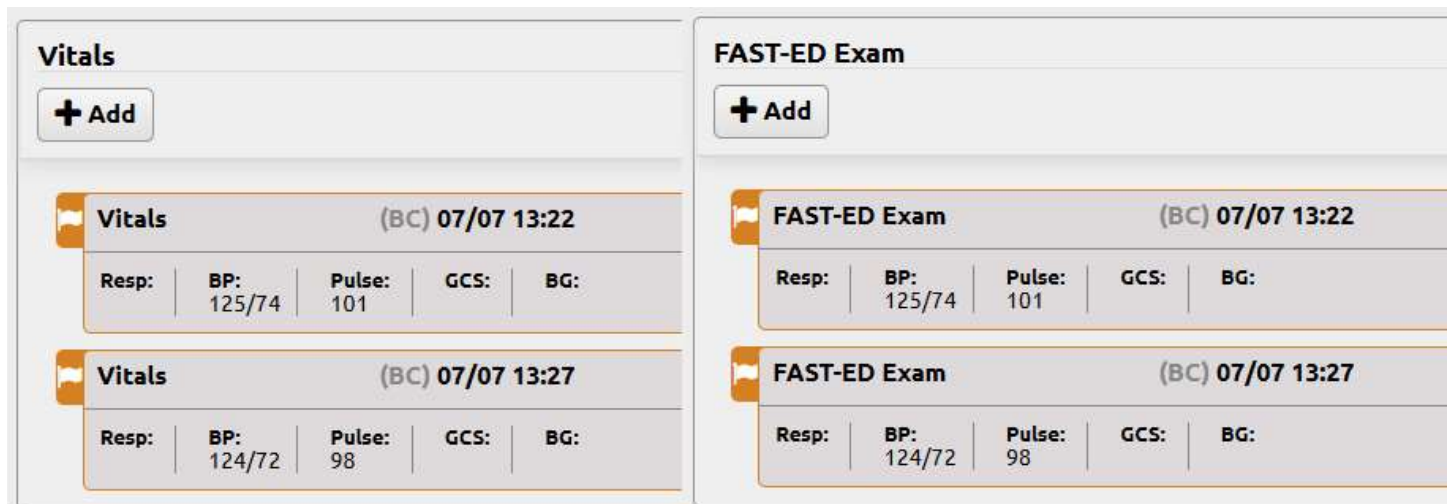


These are the items contained in each section that the corresponding button will display

Are those Vitals or a FAST-ED Exam?

When importing any data from the LifePak, if you access the vitals by clicking the item in the timeline, it opens in the grid labelled "FAST-ED Exam" with the Stroke section defaulted on. This does NOT mean you need to do a stroke assessment for every patient. It is a side-effect of stroke assessment being in the vitals grid and being in the form twice.



Corporate needs you to find the differences between these two grids. – They’re the same grid. It’s a display bug.
